This chart is cross-referenced to the document "A Stokes Family of Dublin", written by A.G. Stokes and represents Sheet 1 of that original document. There are two main later branches, of Stanhaves and Tiberton, and these are shown with separate background colors. Blue lines indicate parentage, and red lines group siblings.

The Connection between the English and Dublin Families

We believe that this lineage represents the ancestry of the Dublin family, to which we certainly belong. However, the exact time is unknown. The evidence for the connection is the coat of arms originally granted to Sir Adam de Stokes in 1306. In 1725 Gabriel Stokes of Dublin successfully petitioned for the right to use these arms. Although his argument, which would have established full details of the descent, is now lost, the link to our family clearly was made.
